To recognize graduating students within the College of Arts & Media who embody the spirit of CAM, we have created the Outstanding Graduate awards.

- Students are nominated by individual faculty who notify the Department Chair.
- The Departmental faculty will then discuss and select their candidates.
- Departments will forward the candidates' names (via letter from nominating faculty) to the Executive Committee.
- The Executive Committee will select the recipient(s) of the award(s).

CRITERIA FOR UNDERGRADUATES

- CU GPA of 3.5 or greater
- Must be a graduating senior in the semester the award is given.
- Evidence of academic excellence both in and outside of the classroom.
- Active citizenship in the Dept, College, University and/or community.

CRITERIA FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS

Minimum Requirements

- Cumulative University of Colorado GPA of 3.700 or higher.
- Must be graduating in the semester the award is given.

Other/General Criteria for Award Consideration

- Growth, development, and demonstration of excellence as a practicing researcher, scholar, and/or artist within the University.
- Actively engaged in professional organizations relevant to the field of study. (Scholarship, presentations, conference participation, etc.)
- Active citizenship in the Department, College, University, and/or community.
- Superior academic achievement and/or collaborative work with faculty.
- Exhibits leadership qualities. (Leadership position in a University or national student organization, Teaching Assistant position, etc.)
