



2022 LYNX National Arts & Media Camps Production Assistant- Recording/ Mixing Specialist

The CU Denver LYNX National Arts and Media Camps (LYNX Camp) is hiring Production Assistants for the 2022 Summer. The programs take place from June 13th- July 29th on the CU Denver campus. The camps are broken into four sessions. Session 1 (one week) includes the following programs: 2D Animation/Illustration; Audio Production/Ableton Live; Mural Creation; Comic Book Character Design; and Photography. Session 2 (two weeks) includes the following program: Music Industry. Session 3 (two weeks) includes the following programs: 2D Animation & Character Creation; 3D Animation & Character Creation; and Filmmaking. Session 4 (one week, online) includes the following program: Comic Book Character Design. LYNX Camp Mission:

The LYNX Camp mission is to effect change by preparing high school students to successfully pursue their artistic passions through higher education.

LYNX Camp students are exposed to the skills they need to foster creativity, learning, and community in a higher education environment in order to reach their full academic potential.

Responsibilities:

The LYNX Production Assistant- Recording/ Mixing Specialist will work 80 hours during the Music Industry camp. Much of the work for this position will happen during week two of the camp (June 27th-30th). Long hours will be required during week two to ensure that all of the student songs get recorded and produced quickly.

Must be available:

- Orientation/Training day end of May or early June- TBD
- June 27th- June 30th in person
- Some independent work after the camp

Required Qualifications:

- Must have completed one full year of college
- Must be a recording arts student with recommendations from staff and/or faculty
- Must have an appreciation of the arts (CU Denver CAM majors preferred)
- **Must be able to available** for all required trainings and days of camp

Preferred Qualifications:

- Prior experience working with high school students
- Prior experience with summer camps
- Prior leadership experiences or interest to learn about leadership
- Current student of the College of Arts and Media

Compensation: Paid in a lump sum of \$1500 for the two weeks including one/two additional days of training prior to the start of camp.
