## 2026 LYNX National Arts & Media Camps LYNX Leader - Sessions Two and Three

The CU Denver LYNX National Arts and Media Camps (LYNX Camp) is hiring LYNX Leaders for the 2026 Summer. The programs take place from June 8<sup>th</sup>- July 24<sup>th</sup> on the CU Denver campus. The LYNX Leaders work during one of our two-week camp sessions: **Session 2 (two weeks)**: Music Industry. **Session 3 (two weeks)** includes the following programs: Animation; Filmmaking; and Visual Immersive Art. ### **LYNX Camp Mission:**

The LYNX Camp mission is to effect change by preparing high school students to successfully pursue their artistic passions through higher education.

LYNX Camp students are exposed to the skills they need to foster creativity, learning, and community in a higher education environment in order to reach their full academic potential.

### **Responsibilities:**

The LYNX Leaders will supervise the high school students attending the LYNX Arts Camps during the non-academic periods of the camp. This includes recreational activities, meals, field trips, bed prep, and all other residential activities. The LYNX Leaders will be provided housing at City Heights during the camp, living on the same floor alongside the residential students attending the camp, and may serve on-call during various evenings.

### **During the camp the LYNX Leaders will:**

- Assist in the implementation of LYNX Camp programs for LYNX students and their families.
- Serve as a role model for LYNX Camp students.
- Create a welcoming and supportive space for a group of residential students that you will meet with daily
- Lead evening & weekend student activities, facilitate student check-in and checkout, and attend field trips with students
- Be prepared to assist with student conflicts or issues that arise in the residential setting
- Hold students accountable for program rules and facilitate conversations when necessary to help enforce these rules
- Supervise and monitor residential students in evenings and during weekend activities
- Inspect rooms & facilitate cleanup
- Assist in airport pick-up/drop-off at beginning and end of camp
- **Attend two full-day staff training sessions prior to camp.**
- **Must be able to work during the middle weekend of camp.**
- Other duties as assigned

**During the weekdays** - Supervise, support, and mentor students during the non-academic portions of the camp. Approximately 4:00pm-9:00am. This includes dinner, after dinner activities, final room checks, and making sure the students arrive for breakfast the next morning.

**During the weekend** - Monitor and supervise students at all times as they attend cultural events, field trips, and workshops. LYNX Leaders will be working all day both Saturday & Sunday of the middle weekend, with breaks provided. The LYNX Camp Coordinator, Graduate Student Coordinator, and Academic Directors will also be supervising students during these events.

**Required Qualifications:**

- Must have completed one full year of college
- Must have an appreciation of the arts (College of Arts & Media majors preferred)
- Must be able to demonstrate high quality of customer care services
- **Must be able to available** for all required trainings and days of camp
  - Trainings will be scheduled the week prior to the start of camp.
- **Must be able to work during the middle weekend of camp.**

**Preferred Qualifications:**

- Prior experience working with high school students
- Prior experience with summer camps
- Prior leadership experiences or interest to learn about leadership
- Current student of the College of Arts and Media

**Compensation:** Paid \$22 an hour for the two weeks including one/two additional days of training prior to the start of camp. LYNX Leaders will also live in City Heights Residence Hall and have all meals provided.
