2026 LYNX National Arts & Media Camps Teaching Assistant

The CU Denver LYNX National Arts and Media Camps (LYNX Camp) is hiring Teaching Assistants for the 2026 Summer. The camps take place from June 8th- July 24th. We will only be offering in-person/on-campus camps this summer. This summer we are offering the following camps and will be hiring at least 1-2 teaching assistants per camp. **If you are going to apply to be a teaching assistant please make sure you are familiar with the content of the program and available for those dates:**

- **2D Animation/Illustration** - On Campus from June 8th-June 12th
- **Audio Production/Ableton Live** - On Campus from June 8th-June 12th
- **Comic Book Character Design** - On Campus from June 8th-June 12th
- **Photography** - On Campus from June 8th-June 12th
- **Music Industry** - On Campus camp from June 14th-June 26th (weekdays only)
- **Animation** - On Campus from July 12th-July 24th (weekdays only)
- **Filmmaking** - On Campus from July 12th-July 24th (weekdays only)
- **Visual Immersive Art** - On Campus from July 12th-July 24th (weekdays only)

LYNX Camp Mission:

The LYNX Camp mission is to effect change by preparing high school students to successfully pursue their creative passions through higher education.

LYNX Camp students are exposed to the skills they need to foster creativity, learning, and community in a higher education environment in order to reach their full academic potential.

Responsibilities:

The LYNX Teaching Assistants will support the high school students attending the LYNX Arts Camps during the academic periods of the camp and assist faculty members in the delivery of the academic programs. This includes assisting instructors with monitoring students, evaluating student work, instructing class workshops, operating classroom technology, assisting with other classroom activities, supervising students during lunch meals and mentoring students. The LYNX Teaching Assistants will be on campus during academic portions of camp (typically 9:00am-5:00pm).

Session One Teaching Assistants **may work up to 40 hours for one week**. Session Two and Three Teaching Assistants **may work up to 80 hours over two weeks**.

During the camp the LYNX Teaching Assistants will:

- Assist in the implementation of LYNX Camp academic programs
- Serve as a role model for LYNX Camp students
- Support faculty member regarding academic curriculum, duties and responsibilities
- Supervise students during lunchtime portion of each academic day
- Hold students accountable for program rules and facilitate conversations when necessary to help enforce these rules
- Attend one all staff training session prior to camp
- Work assigned hours/week during the camp
- Other duties as assigned

Required Qualifications:

- Must have completed one full year of college
- Must have an appreciation of the arts (College of Arts & Media majors preferred)
- **Must be able to available** for all required trainings and days of camp
 - Orientation dates are tentatively scheduled for April 11th and/or May 2nd (only need to attend one)
 - Trainings will be scheduled the week prior to the start of camp.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Student's major matches or closely aligns with the program they are apply to TA

Compensation: \$20 an hour for the entirety of camp, including one/two additional days of training prior to the start of camp. Session One Teaching Assistants can **estimate** to be paid around \$800 (before taxes) for the one week of camp. Session Two and Three Teaching Assistants can **estimate** to be paid around \$1600 (before taxes) for the two weeks of camp.
