Production Assistant- Mixing & Mastering Specialist

The CU Denver LYNX National Arts and Media Camps (LYNX Camp) is hiring Production Assistants for the 2020 Summer. The camps take place from June 8th- July 24th on the CU Denver campus. The camps are broken into three sessions. Session 1 (one week) includes the following programs: Audio Production/Ableton Live; Mural Creation; Comic Book Character Design; Photography; & 2D Animation/Illustration. Session 2 (two weeks) includes the following program: Music Industry. Session 3 (two weeks) includes the following programs: Digital Animation/Motion Graphics; & Filmmaking. LYNX Camp Mission:

The LYNX Camp mission is to effect change by preparing high school students to successfully pursue their artistic passions through higher education.

LYNX Camp students are exposed to the skills they need to foster creativity, learning, and community in a higher education environment in order to reach their full academic potential.

Responsibilities:

The LYNX Production Assistant- Mixing/Mastering Specialist will help with the production needs of our Music Industry Camp. The Mixing/Mastering Specialist will work primarily during the 2nd week of the Music Industry Camp by helping with the recordings of the ensemble classes & then mixing/mastering those recordings. The Mixing/Mastering Specialist may need to work long hours during the 2nd week of camp to ensure that all the student songs get recorded and produced quickly. The Mixing/Mastering Specialist will report to the Production Lead & the Summer Programs Coordinator.

Must be available:

- Orientation/Training day end of May or early June- TBD
- June 22nd- June 26th in person
- Some independent work after the camp

Required Qualifications:

- Must have completed one full year of college
- Must be a recording arts student
- Must have an appreciation of the arts (CU Denver CAM majors preferred)
- **Must be able to available** for all required trainings and days of camp

Preferred Qualifications:

- Prior experience working with high school students
- Prior leadership experiences or interest to learn about leadership
- Current student of the College of Arts and Media

Compensation: Paid in a lump sum of \$1500 for the two weeks including one/two additional days of training prior to the start of camp.
